While driving he wondered what US State he would end up in. Do you know what state he would end up in?



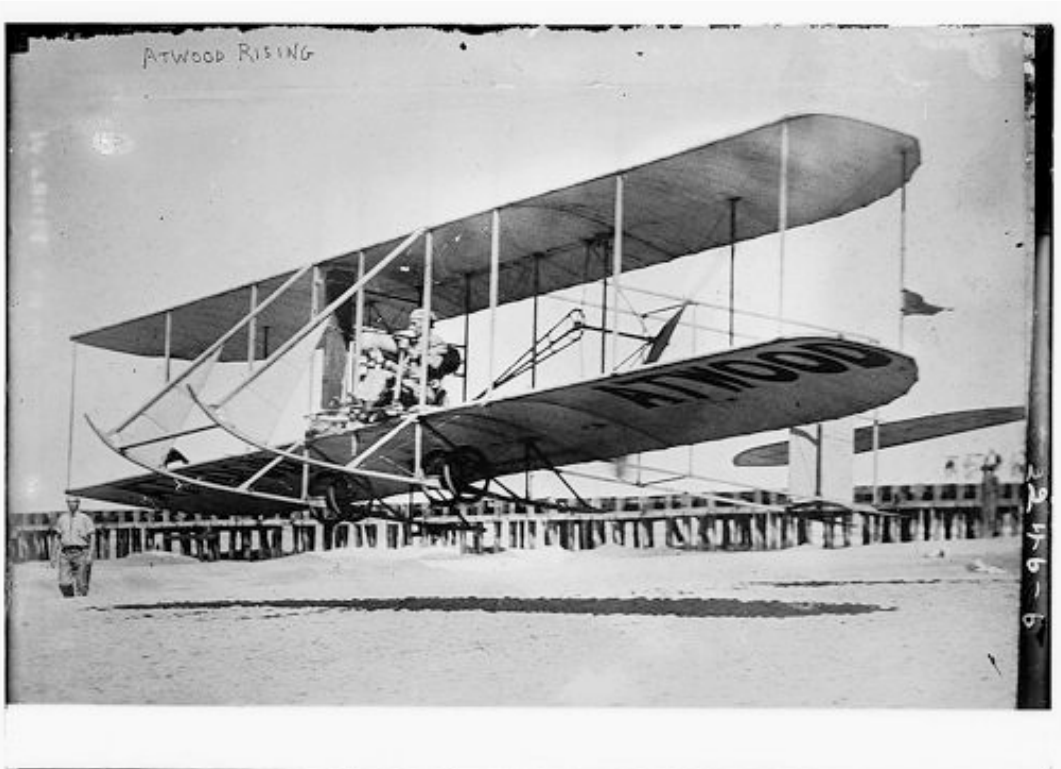
“Cross-country trip? I certainly hope this isn’t another Smokey and the Bandit round.”

Do you know what nickname is given to Ernest Hemingway with regard to his macho persona?



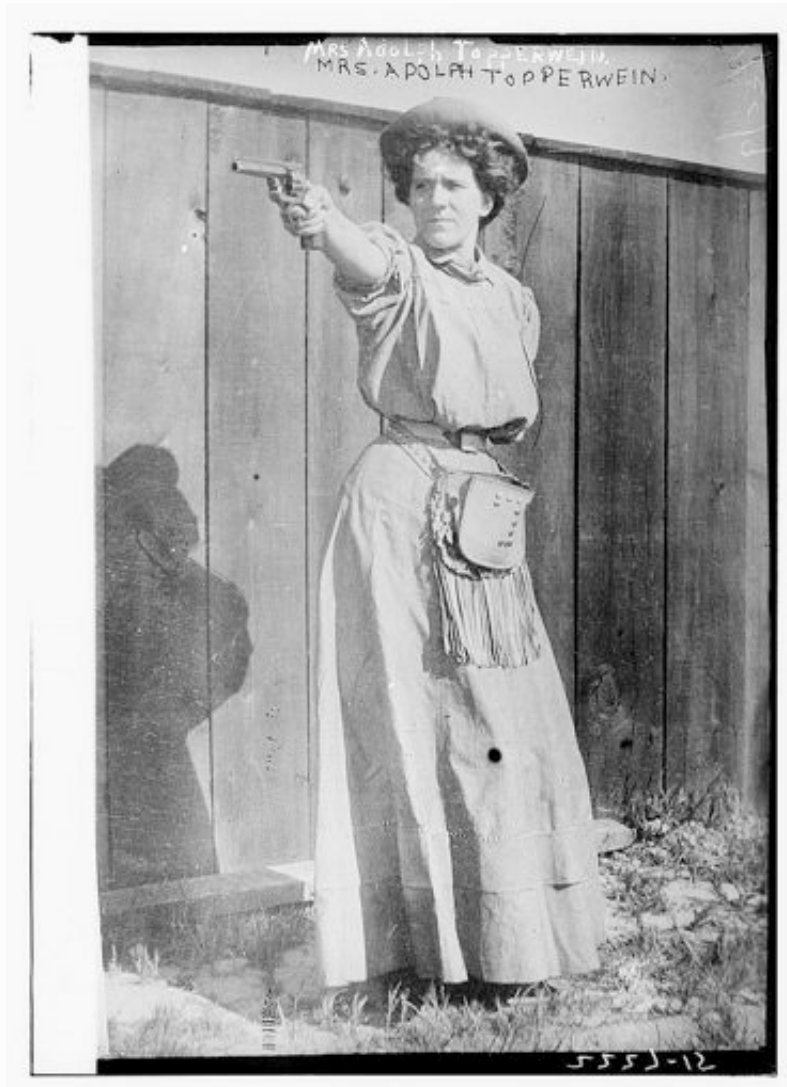


“Just call me Sir Grapefellow!”

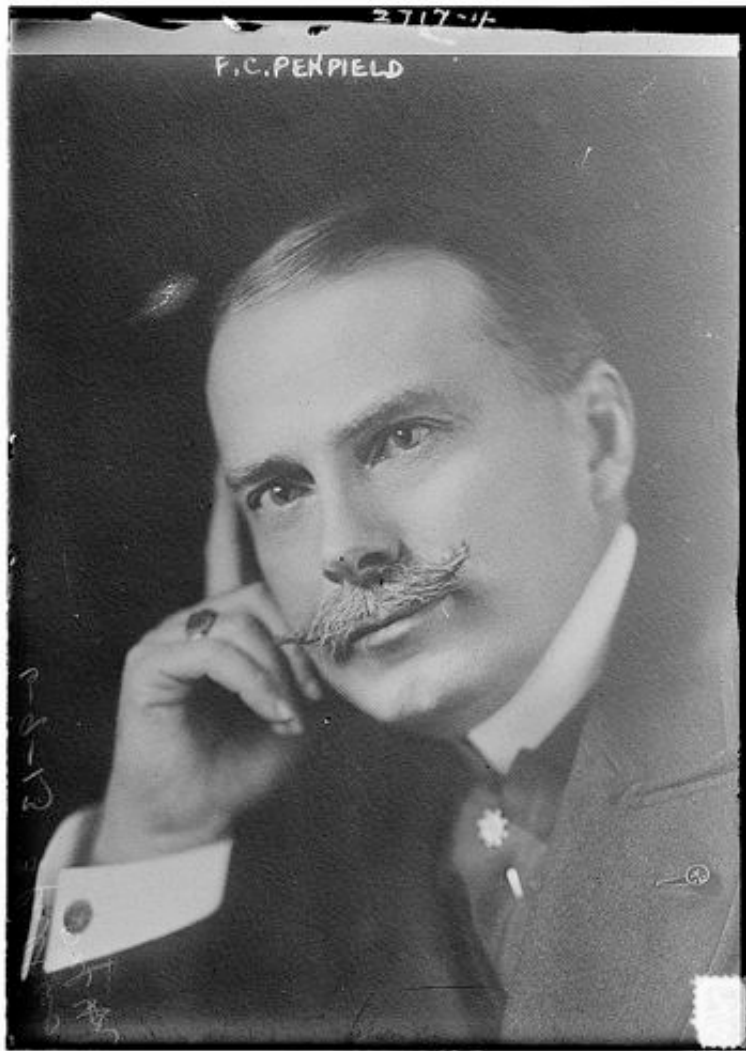
Do you know what celebrity they named their ship after?
